

to manage or control




# Constitutional Convention

Meeting of state delegates in 1787 to revise the Articles of Confederation that eventually lead to the adoption of a new Constitution




## debt

## inclusion


To be included; the inclusion of a bill of rights



## tax

As additional contribution that is added to the cost of a good or service; Taken by the government from a worker's income/business profits; used to pay for government budgeted items

# Shay's rebellion



An uprising of Massachusetts farmers who did not want to lose their farms because of debt caused by heavy state taxes after the American Revolution




trade

# Electoral College

A group of people named by each state legislature to select the president and vice-president of the United States;  
You need 270 electoral votes to become President

## individual rights




Rights that each individual is guaranteed as written in our Bill

of Rights (1<sup>st</sup> 10 amendments in the US Constitution); for example, Freedom of Speech or Right to a trial by jury



# ratify

To approve; To vote the approval of something



# Three-fifths Compromise

Agreement providing that enslaved persons would count as three-fifths of free persons when determining the representation of Congress
